Fiscal Analysis

After initial review, the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) believes the cost to the agency to take over these repairs and maintenance would be Five Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,200,000.00). As ODOT is an appropriated agency, it would need an appropriation of \$5,200,000.00 to cover the increased cost to the agency. Therefore, there would be a fiscal impact to the state budget.
