Fiscal Analysis

The CS to HB1129 increases the small claims court filing fee from \$45 to \$85. Officials with the Administrative Office of the Courts have provided the following information:

Therefore, by increasing the small claims court filing fee from \$45 to \$85, the AOC would expect annual revenues from these collections to increase by roughly \$2,280,176 based on the available data from FY2022 – FY2024.
