**Research Analysis**

HB 1138 directs the Human Capital Management Division and the Civil Service Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to receive and act upon complaints from disciplinary action and grievances filed by state employees employed to perform duties related to peace officers, the Commissioner of Public Safety and the Director of the Department of Corrections. The measure provides these employees are permitted to proceed to a hearing if mediation is unsuccessful.
