Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 1162 restores existing language specifying that the Provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act will not include incidental sales of goat milk where the average monthly number of gallons sold does not exceed 100.

HB 1162 creates the Real Access to Whole Milk Act of 2025 which makes it unlawful for somebody to sell but not distribute milk or milk products without an appropriate and valid permit. The provisions of the act do not include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers at the farm where it is produced where the average number of gallons sold does not exceed 500.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 1162 statutorily changes "distribute" to "sell" in regards to permitting of milk or milk products as well as establishes a threshold for incidental raw milk sales. Upon review, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
