Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 1166 removes the provision that allows municipalities to annex territory without the written consent of a majority of property owners of the proposed territory. Additionally, the measure provides that the required municipal services extension plan be included in both the public notice published in the newspaper and the notice mailed to all owners of proposed territory to be annexed. If the extension of municipal services are not complete within 120 months from the date of annexation, the territory is to be immediately detached.

Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 1166 does not materially alter the prior fiscal impact statement. The measure modifies procedure for annexation of a certain territory without the consent of a majority of owners. The measure deals exclusively with local municipalities, and does not mandate any action or expenditure by a state agency. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
