Research Analysis

HB1182 adds active commission or CLEET-certified agents of the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET) that are hired after July 1, 2025 to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System.

If the new hire working for CLEET is an OLERS retiree, then they will participate and make contributions to the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS) instead. These individuals may also continue to receive unreduced benefits from OLERS while contributing to the OPERS plan.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1182 will add CLEET agency new hires who are law enforcement officers into the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System (OLERS). This measure has been deemed a fiscal retirement bill by the Legislative Actuaries as defined by the Oklahoma Pension Legislation Actuarial Analysis Act (OPLAAA).

OLERS officials anticipate the measure to have an actuarial impact, as all new hires have minor cost to the system. If approved by the committee, the measure will be sent to the Legislative Actuary for actuarial review.
