**Research Analysis**

HB 1191, as introduced, allows any person who engages in the on-farm sale of donkey milk to advertise such donkey milk. The measure also adds donkey milk to provisions in the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act and removes a line in the act that would stop the prohibition on farmers or producers from making cheese using milk or cream produced on the farm.
