Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 1191 restores language that specifies that the provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act will not be construed to prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using milk or cream produced on their farm.

HB 1191 allows any person who engages in the on-farm sale of donkey milk to advertise such donkey milk. The measure also adds donkey milk to provisions in the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act.
