Fiscal Analysis

The POLREC to HB1215 modifies provisions related to certain Human Trafficking crimes, and modifies penalties for some of the crimes. Sentence lengths change from 5 years to life to 5 years to 20 years, unless the victim is under 18 years of age in which cases the sentence length changes from 5 years to life to 5 years to 99 years. Any resulting change in the costs incurred by the Department of Corrections (DOC) are expected to be immaterial and/or absorbed by the agency. Therefore, this measure in its current form is anticipated to be budget neutral.
