**Research Analysis**

The policy committee recommendation for HB 1216 requires fines for any subsequent violation of Construction Industries Board regulations to be five times the amount of the initial offense. The board may begin the fine collection process 90 days after a case is resolved.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The policy committee recommendation for HB 1216 modifies administrative fine guidelines and collections for violations of the acts regulated by the Construction Industries Board. The Construction Industries Board is a non-appropriated state entity. While this measure may result in an unknown increase in fine generation revenue from repeated violations, it is anticipated that this measure will not result in any significant revenue impacts to the state.
