Research Analysis

The amendment to the proposed committee substitute to HB 1219 clarifies that only flags pursuant to federal and state law may be displayed by an agency on state property.

HB 1219, as amended, prohibits state agencies from using state funds to organize or endorse any event, official communication, or educational program that promotes LGBTQI Pride Month. The measure also provides that only flags pursuant to federal and state law may be displayed by an agency on state property.
