Research Analysis

HB 1219 as introduced, prohibits state agencies from using state funds to organize or endorse any event, official communication, or educational program that promotes LGBTQI Pride Month. The measure also prohibits any flag that recognizes sexual orientation or gender identity from being displayed by a state agency on state property.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1219 prohibits the use of state funds for designated purposes and prohibits the display of certain flags on state property. The measure does not mandate any expenditure by a state agency, and any required action at the agency level is expected to be absorbable through existing agency resources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
