Research Analysis

The policy amendment to HB 1270 removes the provision that the failure of ABLE to adhere to the provisions of the measure will result in a presumptive issuance of the license.

HB 1270 provides that ABLE notify an license applicant within 10 days of receipt of all information of any deficiencies in the application and information on the actions that are needed to correct the deficiencies. The applicant will have a reasonable period of time to make corrections. Upon a completed application, ABLE will deliver their verdict within 20 days. If ABLE denies a license, they must specify their reasoning in writing.
