**Research Analysis**

HB 1273 requires that persons convicted of a domestic abuse crime complete an assessment by a certified batterers' intervention program to determine if the person should undergo treatment in a certified batterers' intervention program or through an alternative batterers' intervention program. The measure provides the criteria for alternative batterers' intervention programs.
