## **Research Analysis**

HB 1280, as introduced, requires school districts to spend at least 60 percent of their annual budget on instructional expenditures, as defined in the measure. If a district is not meeting this requirement, it must increase instructional spending by at least 2 percent annually until the 60 percent requirement is met. Failure to increase spending when required will first result in a warning noticed published on the school's website. If a district fails to increase spending and meet the 60 percent requirement for four consecutive years, it will be required to raise all teacher salaries by 2 percent annually until the 60 percent threshold is met.
