The Policy committee recommendation to HB 1360 allows the director of the Oklahoma Attorney General's Address Confidentiality Program to request to a county assessor that personal information regarding a certified Address Confidentiality Program participant, upon the participant's proof of certification, not be made publicly available on the Internet, but instead kept in a secure location at the office of the county assessor where it may be made available to authorized persons pursuant to law.
