Research Analysis

HB 1367, as introduced, provides that an establishment with a license issued by ABLE will not be liable for actions by an employee of the ABLE licensed establishment, unless the actions of the employee are directly attributable to the ABLE licensed establishment. The establishment may provide an affidavit, no later than 10 days after the notice of a violation, that the actions of the employee were not attributable to the establishment. The measure specifies actions that would not be attributable to the ABLE licensed establishment. If it is found that the employee has performed any of these actions on three or more occasions in the last year, this does create a presumption that the ABLE licensed establishment is indirectly encouraging a violation of the law. The measure also lists other factors that present sufficient proof that an ABLE licensed establishment has indirectly encouraged a violation of the law.
