**Research Analysis**

HB1377, as introduced, allows discounts on alcoholic beverages, beer, and wine for members of the United States Armed Forces, however the discount cannot result in a retail price lower than a 6% markup.

Other inducements such as prizes, premiums, or gifts in connection with the sale of alcoholic beverages, beer, or wine remain prohibited.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1377 allows retail alcohol licensees to offer discounts and promotions to members of the United States Armed Forces, provided the discount is compliant with current law, which prohibits discounts greater than six percent (6%). The measure provides an exemption for retail alcohol licensees, which is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
