**Research Analysis**

HB 1380, as introduced, appropriates \$1.1 million to the State Department of Health or so much thereof as may be necessary to administer a public information campaign regarding diabetes care and free and reduced diabetes supplies. The measure also appropriates \$340,222 to the State Department of Health to be administered to federally qualified health centers.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1380 appropriates One Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,100,000) from the General Revenue Fund to the State Department of Health (OSDH) for FY-26 to administer a public information campaign on diabetes care and free or reduced diabetes supplies.

Additionally, Three Hundred Forty Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars (\$340,222) is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to OSDH for FY-26 to administer to federally qualified health centers.

The total appropriation for FY-26 creates a fiscal impact of One Million Four Hundred Forty Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars (\$1,440,222) on the state budget.
