**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 1381 changes some statutory references. The cs also changes the date to prepare an annual report by to February 28 of each year.

HB1381 requires the ABLE Commission to prepare an annual report by February 28 each year, detailing the number of licenses revoked or suspended and the reasons for the actions as well as all complaints; and the number of tickets issued, total ticket amounts, and total penalties. The report must be submitted to the Governor, Speaker of the House, Senate President Pro Tempore, and published on the ABLE Commission's website.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 1381 requires the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission to report annually on the number of licenses revoked or suspended and the reasons for each action, including all complaints submitted to the ABLE Commission. Additionally, the report is to include the number of tickets written and the total amount penalized. The report is to be submitted to the Governor, Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and President Pro-temp of the Oklahoma State Senate, and published online.

ABLE Commission officials confirmed they can include this information in their annual report at no additional cost to the agency, thus having no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
