## **Research Analysis**

The policy committee recommendation for HB 1389 includes contrast-enhanced mammogram and molecular breast imaging to the definition of "diagnostic examination for breast cancer." The measure also adds a definition of supplemental examinations as related to an examination of the breast that is used to screen for breast cancer where there is no abnormality seen or suspected and it is based on personal or family medical history or additional factors. The measure also adds that all health benefit plans include coverage for supplemental examinations for breast cancer.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The policy recommendation to HB 1389 requires health benefit plans to include coverage for contrast-enhanced mammograms and molecular breast imaging as part of diagnostic and supplemental examinations for breast cancer.
