**Research Analysis**

The Floor Substitute for HB 1393 requires the State Board of Education to create a parental consent form for school districts to use when determining whether a student with an IEP will participate in the Oklahoma Alternative Assessment Program (OAAP). The measure lists the requirements of the form, including a statement detailing the benefits and risks of parental consent or refusal.

The measure requires schools to hold an IEP team meeting with the parent if they determine the above actions are necessary. The school is required to notify the parent at least five days before the meeting, unless agreed otherwise.

The school district may not require a student to participate in the OAAP without parental consent unless the school district documents reasonable efforts to obtain consent without parental response or the district obtains approval through a due process hearing.

**DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE COMMITTEE SUB AND FLOOR SUB:**

The Floor sub removes language requiring a school district to try alternative dispute resolution if they cannot agree with the parents.

The Floor sub also removes language detailing a parent's options for responding to the proposed IEP.
