Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 1396 prohibits private schools from requiring a student's parent to participate in the Oklahoma Parental Choice Tax Credit. Further, private schools are required to provide parents who receive a tax credit with a tuition and fees agreement upon enrollment. Lastly, the measure limits tuition and fee increases for private schools receiving the tax credit to a standard inflation measure calculated by the State Treasurer.
