**Research Analysis**

HB 1408, as introduced, requires parents to file a notice of intent with the public school their child attends if they plan to transfer their child to private school or withdraw them and homeschool. The State Department of Education is required to create a notice of intent form for parents to use, and parents must fill it out within 10 days of starting their new school. Lastly, school drop out calculations should not include students withdrawn through this avenue.
