**Research Analysis**

HB 1409 as introduced, allows a public body to require participants included on their email distribution list for public meeting notices to reconfirm their participation annually. Public bodies are allowed to remove participants that do not reconfirm.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1409 permits removal of certain persons from a certain email distribution system. The measure also permits such persons to participate after such removals. The measure does not mandate any action or expenditure by a state agency and is procedurally related to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
