Research Analysis

HB 1411 as introduced, creates the True Grit Trail in eastern Oklahoma. The measure requires the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) to post signs along Oklahoma state highways directing visitors to sites along the trail. Towns and places of interest along the trail include: Sallisaw, Spiro, Bokoshe, McCurtain, Kinta, Quinton, Krebs, McAlester, Hartshorne, Wilburton, Red Oak, Bengal, Talihina, Robbers Cave State Park, and Talimena National Scenic Byway. ODOT and the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department must collaborate to maintain information regarding the True Grit Trail on an online platform.
