The policy committee recommendation for HB 1421 provides that the Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF) must send written notice of the impending license expiration to the animal shelter operator or commercial pet breeder no later than 90 days before the license expiration. ODAFF must provide an online license renewal and payment option by Jan. 1, 2026.

Fiscal Analysis

The policy recommendation to HB 1421 requires the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF) to implement an online renewal and payment system for animal shelter operators and commercial pet breeders by January 1st, 2026.
