Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 1466 gives school districts the opportunity to request a hearing before the State Board of Education if the State Board is considering a reduction in the district's accreditation status. The school district is required to request a hearing within 10 days of notification from the State Board. If the district does not request a hearing within 10 days, their right to one is waived. The State Board of Education must hold the hearing within 30 days of notification from the district. Only evidence relevant to the district's alleged deficiencies may be considered.

Lastly, the measure requires the State Board of Education to promulgate rules for the hearings in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act.
