Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 1493 requires school districts to provide students in grades pre-k – 5 with at least 30 minutes of recess daily. The measure strongly recommends at least 30 minutes of recess for students in grades 6-8. District boards of education can determine the timing and may also break the 30 minutes up in to multiple segments. Recess may not supplant physical education course requirements.
