HB 1496 as introduced, allows a governing body to provide that decisions of the board of adjustment on matters within its jurisdiction are final subject to judicial review, or are final subject to appeal to the council and the right of later judicial review or are advisory to the council. The provisions of this measure only apply to municipalities where the council does not serve as the board of adjustment.
