Research Analysis

The policy recommendation for HB 1521 is mostly cleaning up the statutes regarding high school graduation. The measure makes a few substantive changes. The measure:

- allows computer science courses to fulfill the science requirements for graduation;
- allows an AP English course to count towards the English Language requirements for high school graduation; and
- allows the 1/2 unit of required financial literacy to be fulfilled through an AP course whose content substantially addresses the required concepts.
