**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1522 requires the State Board of Education to issue an RFP for a new statewide student information system by November 1, 2025, and purchase a system by March 1, 2026. The system must be in compliance with the Student Data Accessibility, Transparency and Accountability Act of 2013. The system will be used by all districts for reporting enrollment data, the administration of state tests, the collection of data for the Educational Indicators Program, allocation of state aid, and midyear adjustments. The State Department must implement the new system by July 1, 2027. Prior to full implementation, the Department must provide project management and training to appropriate school personnel.
