HB 1579, as introduced, removes provisions that the salary of the director of the juvenile bureaus must not exceed 90% of that of county Class A officers and that the salary of any other employee must not exceed 85% of class A county officers.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1579 removes the salary cap for directors and employees of a juvenile bureau, eliminating the requirement that their salaries cannot exceed 90% and 85%, respectively, of the salaries of Class A county officers. In its current form, HB 1579 is not anticipated to have a direct impact on the state budget or appropriations.
