**Research Analysis**

The proposed oversight committee substitute for HB 1585 allows pharmacy technician applicants who are at least 17 years old and in approved youth apprenticeship or CareerTech programs to complete Phase II training without being pharmacy employees. All pharmacy technician training programs must be annually approved by the State Board of Pharmacy.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure allows for those age 17 or older and enrolled in a pharmacy technician training program with Career Tech to complete Phase II of the program in a pharmacy that has a program approved by the Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy. Career Tech does not believe the program will increase any costs for them. The Board of Pharmacy is a non-appropriated state agency. Therefore, there should be no fiscal impact to the state.
