Research Analysis

The Policy Recommendation for HB 1592 provides a definition for the elements of organized retail crime and punishments for organized retail crime. If the property is valued less than \$15K, the punishment is up to 5 years in prison or a fine of not more than \$1,000 or both fine and imprisonment. If the property is valued more than \$15K, the punishment is for a term of up to 8 years in prison, a fine of up to \$1,000 or both fine and imprisonment. The measure also lowers the larceny threshold from \$1,000 to \$500. The measure also extends from 180 days, to a one-year period under which separate offenses may be aggregated to determine the total value of the stolen goods. The Oklahoma Organized Retail Crime Task Force is continued until June 1, 2026 and provides that staffing for the task force be provided by the Office of the Attorney General.
