Research Analysis

HB 1598 increases the number of Disabled Veteran license plates that may be issued to an individual from two to four license plates.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1598 amends current law relating to special license plates, specifically the Disabled Veterans License Plates. The measure increases the number of vehicles that an eligible disabled veteran may tag with a Disabled Veterans License Plate from two (2) to four (4), provided each vehicle has a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The average cost of vehicle registration is \$67. A \$5 discounted registration fee per additional license plate would ultimately result in an average cost of \$62.

Per Service Oklahoma, 101,302 Disabled American Veteran registrations were processed in FY-25. Assuming a 50% adoption rate, the estimated fiscal impact is approximately \$3,140,362 per fiscal year. Additionally, implementation of the measure will require a one-time administrative cost of \$56,000 for system updates, which is expected to take approximately eight weeks.
