Fiscal Analysis

HB 1621 creates the Government Spending Transparency Act. The measure requires the Oklahoma State Treasurer (OST) to establish an internet-based portal freely available to the public which details information about certain expenditures. The initial programming setup and launch associated with implementation of the measure are anticipated to cost \$280,000. The resulting annual maintenance is anticipated to cost \$185,000. Per OST, implementation of the measure would require one additional FTE auditor at a cost of \$75,000.
