## **Research Analysis**

HB 1680, as introduced, increases the fee for the cost of personal services as it relates to the Office of Juvenile Affairs reimbursing entities transporting juveniles from \$17 per hour to \$32 per hour.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB1680 increases the reimbursement fee paid by the Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA) to the entity transporting detained juveniles from Seventeen Dollars per hour (\$17/hour) to Thirty-Two Dollars (\$32/hour).

OJA estimates a cost of One Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-One Dollars (\$124,781) due to the fee increase. Officials from OJA stated this cost cannot be easily absorbed and would require additional appropriation, resulting in a fiscal impact of \$124,781 on the state budget.
