Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 1728 creates a new program within the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to eradicate the salt cedar species in Oklahoma counties within the Upper Red River Basin. Per the Conservation Commission, the estimated cost to eradicate these species would range from Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per acre. This measure also creates a revolving fund for the program but does not appropriate any dollars to the fund; therefore, this measure has no direct fiscal considerations for the state.
