Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 1764 prohibits any person from setting up unauthorized camps on county-owned and municipal-owned lands. An *unauthorized camp* is defined in the measure as any tent, shelter, or bedding constructed for overnight sleeping on property not designated as a campsite. Counties and municipalities can opt out of the provisions of the measure by passage of majority vote of the governing body.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1764 amends current law to include county-owned and municipal-owned lands for purposes of prohibiting unauthorized camps. The Oklahoma Department of Public Safety does not collect any portion of municipal fines or fees. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
