## **Research Analysis**

The policy committee recommendation to HB 1764 prohibits any person from setting up unauthorized camps on county-owned and municipal-owned lands. An *unauthorized camp* is defined in the measure as any tent, shelter, or bedding constructed for overnight sleeping on property not designated as a campsite. Counties and municipalities can opt out of the provisions of the measure by passage of majority vote of the governing body.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The policy committee recommendation to HB 1764 adds language permitting counties and municipalities to opt out by a majority vote by the respective governing bodies. The measure does not materially alter the prior fiscal impact statement. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
