Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB1777 amends the Oklahoma Citizen Participation Act to exclude from the act, any civil action arising from an officer-director, employee-employer, or independent contractor relationship that seeks recovery for misappropriation of trade secrets or corporate opportunities, or seeks to enforce a non-disparagement, non-compete, non-disclosure or confidentiality agreement.
