Research Analysis

The floor substitute for HB 1810 requires all utilization review entities contracted to perform prior authorization services for Medicaid plans to meet the requirements of the Ensuring Transparency in Prior Authorization Act, excluding its provisions for chronic conditions and severability.

CHANGES IN FLOOR SUBSTITUTE FROM INTRODUCED VERSION:

The floor substitute modifies the sections of the Ensuring Transparency in Prior Authorization Act that contracted utilization review entities must meet by removing the provisions on chronic conditions and severability. The substitute also adds instances that fall under the definition of *children's specialty plan* in the Ensuring Access to Medicaid Act.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1810 modifies the requirements for utilization review entities contracted with the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA), requiring their prior authorization processes to align with the requirements of the Ensuring Transparency in Prior Authorization Act.

The floor amendment extends the implementation date for certain populations within the Children's Specialty Plan.

In its current form, OHCA does not anticipate that the measure will impact the Medicaid program, thus having no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
