HB 1815, as introduced, provides that the Conservation Commission will have the power and duty to enter into contracts and agreements and execute instruments deemed necessary, beneficial, or convenient by the Commission for exercising its legally conferred powers. The measure also adds a number of definitions to the Conservation District Act.
