HB 1819, as introduced, increases the cap on the yearly optometry license fee set by the Board of Examiners in Optometry from \$300 to \$500.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1819 increases the cap on annual licensing fees that the Board of Examiners in Optometry can charge to practice optometry in the state, raising it from Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500). The increase in fee revenue is anticipated to be minimal; therefore, HB 1819 is not anticipated to have a direct impact on the state budget.
