**Fiscal Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 1833 creates the Rethinking Paying Subminimal Wage to Persons with Disabilities Task Force to develop a plan to phase out the practice of paying workers with disabilities subminimum wages. The 11-member task force will serve without compensation, however, may receive reimbursement for travel contingent on the availability of private funds. Therefore, HB 1833 is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
