Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 1833 establishes the 11-member Rethinking Paying Subminimum Wage to Persons with Disabilities Task Force to operate until May 31, 2026. The task force must develop a plan to phase out subminimum wage payments to workers with disabilities under 14(c) certificates. The goal is to transition these workers to competitive, integrated employment at or above minimum wage, and, when necessary, alternative day programs for those not able or interested in transitioning. The task force must identify potential obstacles, minimize negative impacts, and create a timeline for the plan. The final report must be submitted to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and Speaker of the House by January 1, 2026.
