## **Research Analysis**

HB 1836 as introduced, modifies the definition of *qualified nonprofit agency for the employment* of people with significant disabilities as it relates to the State Use Advisory Council by reducing the required percent of direct labor hours persons with significant disabilities engage in certain labor activities from 75 percent to 50 percent. The measure also modifies the definition of *person* with significant disabilities as it relates to the State Use Advisory Council to include a blind person as defined in this measure and individuals with intellectual disabilities or developmental disabilities as defined in Section 1408 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statues.
