Research Analysis

The floor amendment to HB 1847 requires the Department of Human Services to work with the Oklahoma State Fire Marshal to develop guidelines that allow family child care homes and large child care homes to operate under the requirements of the 2018 International Residential Code as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission. The care homes will not be denied a license to operate should they comply with these requirements. No political subdivision will place stricter fire and life safety requirements.

CHANGES IN FLOOR SUB VERSION FROM COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE:

The floor amendment changes the requirements that family child care homes and large child care homes must operate on after guidelines are created to those of the 2018 International Residential Code as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission rather than International Fire Code.

Fiscal Analysis

The floor amendment to HB 1847 directs the Department of Human Services to work with the State Fire Marshal to develop guidelines that allow certain child care homes to operate under the requirements of the 2018 International Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission (OUBCC).

In its current form, HB 1847 is not anticipated to directly impact the state budget or appropriations.
