Research Analysis

HB 1847, as introduced, requires the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission to adopt the International Residential Code for two-unit to six-unit residential buildings. The measure also requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to work with the State Fire Marshal to develop guidelines that allow family child care homes and large child care homes to operate under the fire protection requirements of the International Residential Code. These child care homes will not be denied an operation license if they comply with code requirements. No agency, municipality, county or other state political subdivision can make stricter fire requirements than the ones in the International Residential Code.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1847 requires the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission to adopt standards according to the International Residential Code for two-unit to six-unit residential buildings. Additionally, the Department of Human Services is to work with the State Fire Marshal to develop guidelines for operating under the International Residential Code.

In its current form, HB 1847 is not anticipated to directly impact the state budget or appropriations.
